




CREATE A NEW USER ACCOUNT: instructions for use

If you already have a Science Conf account: log in!
If you do not have a Science Conf account: you need to create one using the form opposite

- 1 Enter your email adresse
- 2 Login: you have to choose a login for the Scienceconf.org platform
- 3 Choose a password & re-type it
- 4 Enter your lastname & firstname
- 5 Choose the default language of the website : all the texts of the interface (home, menu, content) will be posted in the selected language
- 6 Prove that you're human by answering questions
- 7 Click on «Create account»: Within a few minutes, you will receive an email enabling you to activate your new account and log in to the interface by clicking on the link in the email.








1 Log in to the conference using your Science Conf identifiers: this takes you to the conference home page, which contains information about the conference and various sections (access, programme, etc.).














SUBMITTING ABSTRACTS: instructions for use part 3 - File(s)






- Here we are at stage 3 of the abstract submission form: you can add a file to your deposite
- Click on «Parcourir» (browse): select your file and click on «Upload» : the file will appear below in the folder «File» lci, vous pouvez renseigner le type de fichier téléchargé, et éventuellement ajouter une description
- You can also upload your file via a URL link or by embedding its HTML code
- Good to know (at any time and at any stage of the deposit process), you can modify your deposit via the **Actions** section: click on the cross to delete the file
- Once your file has been uploaded (not compulsory), click on Next step


This window shows the title of your abstract, the number of authors (if any), the affiliations you have entered, the attached file (if you have uploaded one) and the theme(s) you have selected.

At this stage, you can check that all the information in your application is correct, and return to the previous steps if necessary (by clicking on Metadata, Author(s) ou File(s).

- If everything is OK, all that's left to do is send your summary by clicking on «Submit»
- A confirmation window will inform you that the submission has been saved.
